

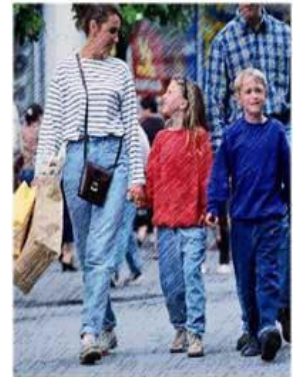
Sally's Children
